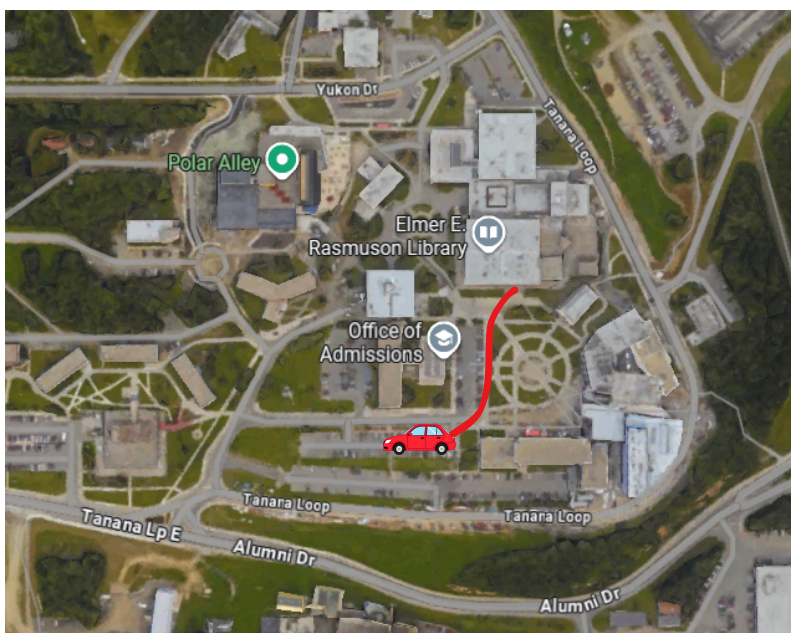


Visiting UAF Alaska and Polar Regions Collections & Archives (APRCA)



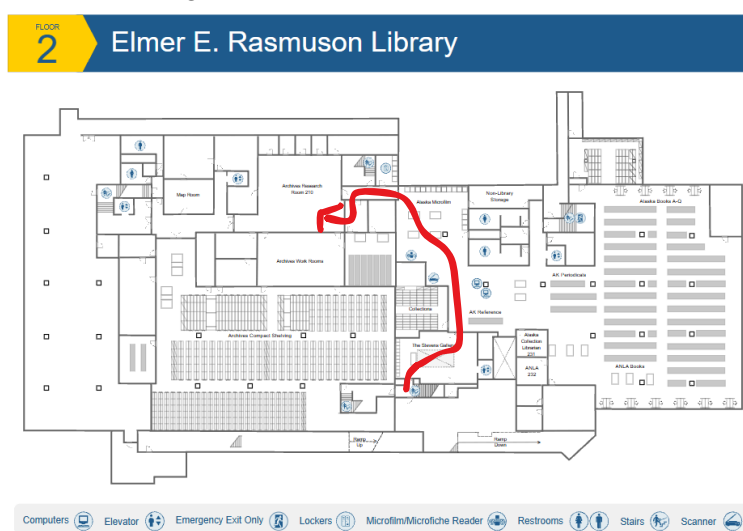
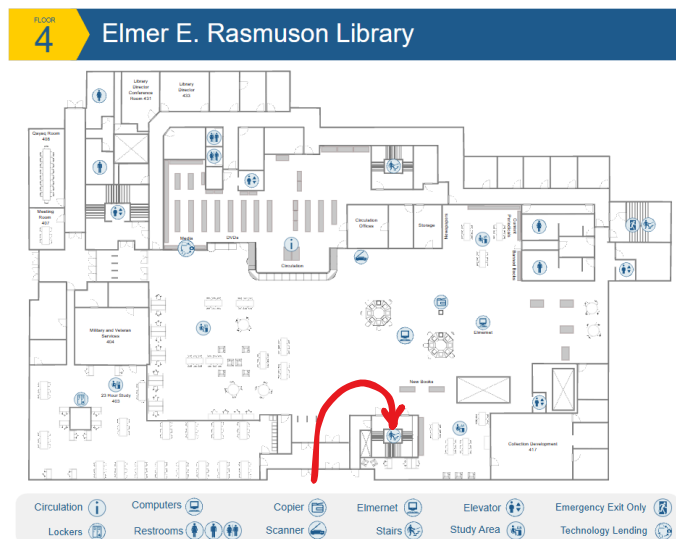
The Archives is located inside the Rasmuson Library at UAF.

The entrance to the library from the parking lot is on 4th floor (ground level). See picture of Floor 4 below.

After entering the library, turn right and take stairway to **descend** two floors to the 2nd floor (or take the elevator down to the 2nd floor).

See picture of Floor 2 below. Walk through the small art gallery, and head toward the microfilm and microfiche drawers area. Archives doorway is in the corner of that area in a narrow hallway.

Someone will greet you when you enter. Sign in and the archivist will instruct you how to begin.



The Archives Research Room is open by appointment, Mon-Fri, 10:00am-12:00pm & from 1:00pm to 4:00pm.

APRCA curators, archivists and staff are available for consultation by appointment Mon-Fri.
